2) Community Organizing ~ The Wildfire Churches have received an Imagination Grant from the Minneapolis Area Synod of \$7,500! It has been decided to use this grant to hire a part-time community organizer to work within the eight congregations of Wildfire for the next six months.

Community organizing can take many forms. A community organizer is someone who gets to know a community of people through one-on-one conversations in order to find out what common goals the people of the community seek and what power they hold that could help them achieve those goals.



## Transition Team Report – June 11, 2019

We've been busy since the last report was submitted.

### On May 28th:

- 1. We started with a word from Paul in 2 Corinthians about the fact that things may not always go smoothly, but that Paul was content with all of it in doing the work of God.
- 2. We discussed the Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT)
  - A. This can be done online or in paper form. Those done on paper will have to be reentered into the online format.
  - B. We discussed the areas the CAT covers: Level of satisfaction and energy, critical success factors, pinpoint strengths, members' vision of the future, gauge readiness for change, uncover potential resources, prep for Call process
  - C. Our CAT can be customized. There are set questions, but then we can select two additional modules and additional questions.
- 3. We reviewed a sample CAT and chose 2 optional modules. We also selected 5 additional questions to add to our specific CAT.
- 4. We decided that we will reconvene on June 4 to facilitate forward movement.
- 5. We discussed the steps involved in announcing the upcoming study. We will ask Dan to announce that the study is coming up and to look out for it.
- 6. We discussed our Brooklyn Center, Brooklyn Park/Community
  Assessment as Eilert brought in some stats that he got from the cities.
  Caucasian, Mexican, Somolian and other Africans are the most common ethnographies represented.
- 7. We adjourned in prayer.

- 10. We will receive results in three forms: a summary for the congregation, and also a video chat and a comprehensive report for the Team and the use of the Call Committee once convened. It will also be useful for the pastors considering Cross of Glory.
- 11. We adjourned with prayer.
