We will end this time together by singing: Praise God, from whom all blessings flow; Praise Him, all creatures here below; Praise Him above, ye heavenly host; Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost.

L: Go in praise and thanksgiving, for God goes with you.

A: Thanks be to God! POSTLUDE

A basket for Thanksgiving offering is located on the table at the back of the sanctuary. Thank you for generously sharing the gifts that God has abundantly given us!

The sanctuary will remain open for meditation and prayer. You're welcome to linger here as long as you'd like, before joining us for the community meal located in the Fellowship Hall.
