Taking Root

One of the first things I noticed here at Cross of Glory were a dozen or so raised garden beds in the back of the building, bursting with green growth. Some of the growth is probably weeds, but much of it looks like fruit and vegetable plants (I'll keep you posted). In my first days here, I've learned this little community garden is cared for by church members and neighbors, that produce has been donated to the CEAP food shelf, and that students at Progeny Academy would love to take part. I'm excited to learn more about this garden and to watch what will grow--literally and figuratively.

The Gospel text this week is the Parable of the Sower, a story about how God extravagantly sows seeds on all kinds of different ground. We too are called into the work of sowing, not knowing what will grow, but trusting that God is alive and at work.

As we begin to imagine together the things that--by God's grace--will take root in our life together here at Cross of Glory, I wanted to share an invitation to take part in a Meet-and-Greet in the coming weeks.
